



TENNESSEE ALPACA ASSOCIATION SCARF COMPETITION!

The Tennessee Alpaca Association is sponsoring an alpaca scarf competition to promote the use of alpaca fiber produced right here in Tennessee. The rules are few and simple. Hopefully this competition will grow and become a regular event.

The contest is open to any TN resident. Alpaca fiber/yarn must come from a TAA member farm. (see www.tnalpaca.org for a complete list of TAA member farms and entry form)

First prize in each category is \$200.

Scarves are to be made of a minimum of 50% alpaca fiber.

Scarves are to be approximately 60 inches long and 8 inches wide.

You may enter as many scarves as you like. Please fill out a separate form with \$10 fee (this fee includes return postage) for each entry. TAA member farm business card or label from yarn/fiber must be included with each entry. By entering the contest, you agree to allow TAA the ability to showcase your entry in promotional printed materials and displays.

Southern Highland Craft Guild members Shereen Franklin and Geri Forkner will judge all entries. Shereen and Geri are accomplished fiber artists with extensive experience working with alpaca fiber.

1. Handspun, hand knit
2. Millspun, handknit
3. Handspun, crochet
4. Millspun, crochet
5. Handspun, handwoven
6. Millspun, handwoven
7. Felt

All entries are to be mailed to J Bennett, 1120 Hwy 307, Sweetwater, TN 37874 by April 1, 2010 for judging. Winners will be notified by email/phone. Winning entries will be displayed on the TAA website and at several travelling locations throughout Tennessee.
